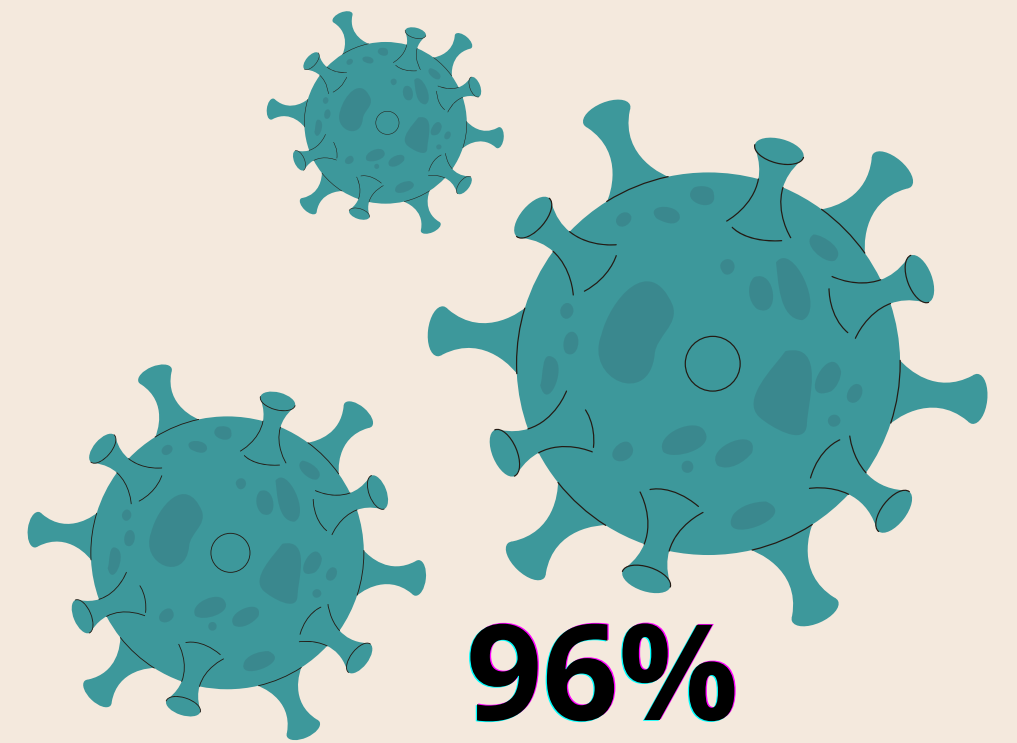




COVID-19 IN HAEMOGLOBINOPATHY AND RARE ANAEMIAS

**As of November 2021:
864 people have had COVID-19
out of ~15,000 people living with
these conditions in UK**

- About half have needed hospital admission
- About 1 in 10 patients admitted to hospital needed intensive care to help with their breathing
- 30 patients (4%) have died of COVID-19
- No one under the age of 20 years has died of COVID 19

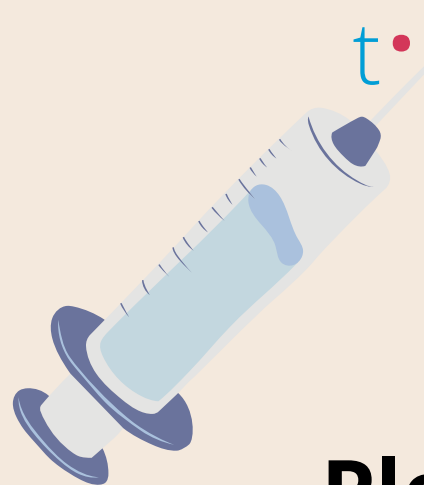
